This tournament is organized for the enjoyment and benefit of all participants. Everyone is expected to behave and act as a representative of the Christian Orthodox faith during this tournament. As it is the participant's right to have choices, it is also the participant's responsibility to accept the effects of their choices. Mix has a responsibility to ensure that all youth and servants are provided with a welcoming, caring, respectful and safe environment. This environment should be free from bullying, harassment, and violence. All those participating must share in the responsibility for eliminating bullying, discrimination, harassment, and violence. There will be consequences if allegations of such behaviors are true. Parents of all participants agree that their children will adhere to the following guidelines and expectations on this trip:

- In rare cases, servants may need to search bags and/or rooms due to concerns for their safety and well-being. Youth and parents agree to this action when warranted.
- Youth are expected to follow the leadership of the servants and fully respect their decisions to ensure everyone's safety.
- Be on time for all scheduled events as announced by the servants.
- Abstain from making derogatory comments, bullying or excluding others at any time during the trip.
- Attend the liturgy and all spiritual sessions.
- Refrain from meddling, complaining, and using obscene or insensitive humor.
- For everyone's safety, all are expected to abide by the curfews in the schedule.
- As Christians, we accept to leave the place we visit in a clean and good condition, as such, damage to the rooms will not be accepted or tolerated.
- Ensure that the servants know where you are at all times.

- Understand that overnight trips can be difficult, and adopt a flexible attitude, as plans may need to change.
- Respect the advice given concerning attire, eating, and drinking.
- As we are God's children and hold dear our Christian values, it is expected that no one will use or possess vapes, tobacco, marijuana, alcoholic beverages, or illegal drugs at any time. Such behavior will not be tolerated at all.
- In rare circumstances, servants may need to make health related decisions in emergency situations on behalf of the youth.
- **No Youth should be driving to the valley. They will be sent back.**
- **Youth who will be dropped off by their parents must inform us through email (admin@hsmix.ca)**
- All youth must respect and abide by the curfew. No youth can be out of their building past 11:00 PM and must be in their rooms by 1:00 Am.

Anyone found to be in violation of the code of conduct accepts that they may not be allowed to continue to participate in the tournament
